### I. PURPOSE

To provide a general description of Lionsgate Academy's staff dress code policy.

## II. GENERAL STATEMENT OF POLICY

- A. Lionsgate Academy's charter clearly indicates that the school's focus is on transition to adulthood. Therefore, employees should model acceptable dress for a place of work. A neat and professional appearance is expected of all employees of Lionsgate Academy.
- B. Clothing and accessories must be free of anything that may substantially interrupt the educational process, including images or slogans, drugs, cigarettes, sexual connotations, alcohol-related graphics, or other negative attitudes. Lionsgate uses the Anti-defamation League's *Hate Symbols Database* to determine if a particular symbol can be used as a hate symbol.
- C. Employees should wear clothing that allows them to participate fully in their assigned job duties. Jewelry which may or may not include piercings, may be deemed a work hazard and falls into this policy.
- D. The standard for professional dress is the responsibility of the building principal or site administrator. Lionsgate Academy will reasonably accommodate a staff member's religious beliefs in terms of workplace attire unless the accommodation creates an undue hardship.
